Central Precinct Public Meeting

Transport for NSW has lodged a rezoning proposal with the Department of Planning and Environment (the Department) to develop the area in and around Central Station. I invite you to a public meeting about the proposal.

When: Monday 5 September 2022, 6pm to 7pm

Where: Lower Town Hall, Sydney Town Hall, 483 George Street, Sydney

Transport for NSW will present its proposal, which is open for public comment until Monday 19 September. You will have the opportunity to ask questions, and your feedback will help inform the City's submission.

About the proposal

Transport for NSW's proposal seeks to create:

- 24 hectares of land, including 15 buildings between 4 and 34 storeys above and around the intercity rail lines
- A new technology and innovation precinct, creating 16,000 jobs
- 850 residential units, including 15% affordable housing and a target of 15% diverse housing, such as student housing
- Two hectares of open space, including parks, plazas and squares
- New bridges across the railway connecting Surry Hills to Haymarket and Chippendale, and Redfern to Chippendale
- Upgrades to the rail infrastructure.
