



## Transport Access Program

### Overview

The NSW Government is committed to improving public transport services and providing a world-class transport system people want to use.

On the 23rd April 2012 the NSW Government announced a new Transport Access Program which will deliver accessible, modern, secure and integrated transport infrastructure where it is needed most. This includes station upgrades, better interchanges, ferry wharf upgrades and commuter car parks. The Transport Access Program includes more than \$770 million over four years.
