Take Col's walk (or drive) to Shepherd Street, Darlington, and at 11.30 am assemble on the corner of Shepherd and Abercrombie Streets, to join a public procession with the funeral hearse to the "Block" in Eveleigh Street Redfern.

At 12 noon on the Block a salute to Col's coffin will take place before the funeral hearse leaves for the crematorium.

12.15 a public "Celebration of Colin's Life" will commence upstairs in the Redfern Community Centre, 29-53 Hugo Street Redfern,, with film footage of Col, and a slide presentation.

At aproximately 1.15pm when Col's family return from the crematorium a wake will formally commence MC'd by friend and colleague of Col's, Rick Lepastrier. Speakers will cover the broad range of Colin's influence across multiple fields of his working career.

The Commemoration to Col will complete the circle of an extraordinary life.

In case you wish to have a last word about CoI, there will be a talking tent and video recorder to document your comments.
