REZONING PROPOSAL TO REDEVELOP EXPLORER STREET PUBLIC HOUSING ESTATE

The NSW Department of Planning and Environment will provide a pre-exhibition presentation on the Explorer Street, Eveleigh public housing rezoning proposal.

Background

The Explorer St public housing estate was identified as a site to be redeveloped in 2020. Land and Housing Corporation undertook pre-lodgement consultation, presenting three options to the community. No planning proposal to rezone the site was undertaken, and in 2022 it was announced that the NSW Government will be the consent authority for the site, not the City of Sydney Council.

What next?

The rezoning proposal will set the height limits, floor space and other controls. Following rezoning, a development application will outline finer details of what will be proposed, including the mix of social, public and affordable housing. This will be determined by the NSW Government.
